TOILET IS NOW OPEN BUT MUST BE SANITISED AFTER EVERY USE, HOLY COMMUNION AT THE ALTAR RAILS 3 EACH SIDE IF SEATED ON LEFT GO ON LEFT, IF SEATED ON RIGHT, GO TO RIGHT. THOSE RECEIVING ON TONGUE RECEIVE LAST.

ANNUAL THANKSGIVING MASS: THE ANNUAL DIOCESAN THANKSGIVING MASS FOR MARRIAGE WILL TAKE PLACE ON SUNDAY 9TH OCTOBER, 12 NOON AT ST CHAD'S CATHEDRAL. BAPTISMS: PARENTS & GOD PARENTS WISHING TO HAVE THEIR BABY BAPTISED, MUST, AS A SIGN OF THEIR COMMITMENT, UNDERTAKE TO ATTEND SUNDAY MASS ON A REGULAR BASIS BEFORE THE AGREED DATE OF BAPTISM, THIS APPLIES TO THOSE WHO ARE CATHOLICS ONLY.

ADULTS WISHING TO BE BAPTISED MUST ALSO ATTEND CHURCH ON A REGULAR BASIS, AS A SIGN OF THEIR SERIOUS INTENT TO UNDERGO A PERIOD OF PREPARATION INVOLVING INSTRUCTIONS IN THE FAITH. INITIAL ENQUIRY BY EMAIL CANNOT BE PROCESSED UNTIL THE PERSON/S MAKE AN APPOINTMENT TO SEE FR PAUL FIRST.
