USUAL PROCEDURES WILL BE FOLLOWED, STEWARDS ON DUTY SATURDAY & SUNDAY. ONE-WAY SYSTEM. SOCIAL DISTANCING AT ALL TIMES ETC. TOILETS ARE NOW OPEN BUT MUST BE SANITISED AFTER EVERY USE.
HOLY COMMUNION AT THE ALTAR RAILS IF SEATED ON LEFT GO ON LEFT, IF SEATED ON RIGHT, GO TO RIGHT. THOSE RECEIVING ON TONGUE RECEIVE LAST.
STEWARDS WILL LEAD TO HOLY COMMUNION AT WEEKENDS, BUT EXIT AT THE END OF MASS WILL BE FREE FLOW DUE TO MASKS BEING MANDATORY. PLEASE REMEMBER TO KEEP YOUR DISTANCE. STAY SAFE!
NO STEWARDS DURING WEEK BUT USUAL GUIDELINES APPLY.
MAY WE PLEASE REMIND YOU THAT FACE COVERINGS ARE NOW MANDATORY – PLEASE BRING ONE WITH YOU. (UNLESS YOU ARE MEDICALLY EXEMPT)
