#### **NEW PROCEDURE:**

To bring some normality back to Mass, we will now have a proper dismissal and blessing, the following procedure will be <u>implemented from Tuesday 13th</u>

<u>April.</u>

Stewards will lead those going to Holy Communion or for a Blessing as follows: Our Lady's side - from back pew, (No 8) down middle aisle to Altar and return to pew down Our Lady's side. If you are not going up to the Altar, please indicate to the steward and remain in your pew.

Then from back pews centre aisle left & right, down to Altar then either left or right depending on which side you are sitting, returning back to pews down either Our Lady's or Sacred Heart side. The tapes on the end of these pews will now be removed to gain access.

Finally the Sacred Heart side from back pew (No 8) down centre aisle to Altar and back to pew down Sacred Heart side.

When receiving Holy Communion please keep your face mask on, receive HC in hand step to the right or left and lift mask and consume host, then return to pew.

At the end of mass, after the final blessing and dismissal, stewards will lead you out of Church via the porch and front entrance, the sacristy will no longer be the exit.

The order will be Our Lady's side, centre aisles then Sacred Heart side, all from back pews first.

Please observe social distancing at all times, and leave the Church grounds as quickly as possible. Thank you all for your cooperation, and stay safe.
