EASTER AT ST MARY'S:

WE RECENTLY RECEIVED GUIDANCE FROM THE CATHOLIC BISHOPS' CONFERENCE OF ENGLAND & WALES FOR LENT AND EASTER. YOU WILL BE PLEASED TO HEAR THAT THERE CONTINUES TO BE A DIRECTION OF TRAVEL TO RETURN TO WHAT WAS NORMAL WHEN ATTENDING MASS AT ST. MARY'S. YOU WILL BE UPDATED ON FULL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE EASTER TRIDUUM OVER THE NEXT FEW WEEKS. WE CAN ADVISE THAT THE VENERATION OF THE CROSS HAS BEEN RESTORED FOR GOOD FRIDAY BUT WILL INVOLVE TOUCHING THE CROSS ONLY. STEWARDS WILL REMAIN ON DUTY ON SATURDAY & SUNDAY UP TO AND INCLUDING THE EASTER VIGIL & EASTER SUNDAY. THEREAFTER, THE STEWARDING ROLE WILL NO LONGER BE IN PLACE. AGAIN, WE MUST THANK THOSE WHO HAVE GIVEN THEIR TIME OVER ALMOST TWO YEARS TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF ATTENDING ST. MARY'S. PLEASE CONTINUE THE PRACTICE OF SANITISING ON ENTRY & EXIT. PLEASE HAVE REGARD TO SOCIAL DISTANCING. THE WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS IS OPTIONAL. HOLY COMMUNION ARRANGEMENTS REMAIN AS CURRENT BUT SUBJECT TO REVIEW IN LINE WITH THE STEWARDING ARRANGEMENTS ENDING AT EASTER. PLEASE NOTE COULD THOSE RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION ON THE TONGUE. PLEASE CONTINUE TO RECEIVE LAST. TOILETS ARE OPEN BUT MUST BE SANITISED AFTER EVERY USE.
