FROM NEXT WEEK THERE WILL BE NO STEWARDS AT WEEKDAY MASSES, BUT THE GUIDELINES THAT ARE IN PLACE NOW SHOULD STILL BE FOLLOWED: SANITISE ON ENTRY AND EXIT, THERE WILL BE A LIST ON THE TABLE IN THE PORCH FOR TRACK & TRACE IF YOU COULD PLEASE TICK BY YOUR NAME IF ATTENDING, OR ADD NAME ETC IF NOT ON THE LIST. WE MUST KEEP TO SOCIAL DISTANCING AT ALL TIMES. FOLLOW SAME PROCEDURE FOR HOLY COMMUNION AND THOSE RECEIVING ON THE TONGUE SHOULD RECEIVE LAST. MASKS TO BE WORN ON ENTRY AND EXIT AND FOR GOING TO HOLY COMMUNION, BUT YOU MAY REMOVE THEM WHILST SEATED IF YOU WISH. THE CHURCH WILL BE SANITISED EVERY FRIDAY READY FOR THE WEEKEND. *I WOULD LIKE TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO THANK ALL THE STEWARDS AND SANITISERS WHO HAVE WORKED SO HARD FOR THE LAST 16 MONTHS TO ENABLE US TO KEEP OUR CHURCH OPEN, AND FOR CARRYING ON FOR AS LONG AS IS REQUIRED.
