Fr Paul's message:
My dear friends,
We have at last been allowed to celebrate Mass together and that is very good news. And so I look forward to welcoming you to Church this weekend. Sadly the present guidelines laid down are very restrictive in their nature and so we are not yet back to normal.
In particular, the freedom given for you to receive in the traditional manner has been taken away, so that you must receive Holy Communion standing and in the hand. A number of you have already expressed your sadness about this, and it is a sadness that I share strongly. Let us hope that as we move forward things will change. Remember going to Mass does not mean you are obliged to receive Communion. If you wish to receive Communion you must consume the Sacred Host in front of the priest before moving away to the exit.
I ask for your prayers as I seek to balance the general good of the parish and my conscience.
