UPDATED INFORMATION FROM THE BISHOPS CONFERENCE OF ENGLAND AND WALES:

AT ST MARY'S, STEWARDS WILL REMAIN ON DUTY ON SATURDAY & SUNDAY BUT IS SUBJECT TO FURTHER REVIEW.
PLEASE HAVE REGARD TO SOCIAL DISTANCING.
THE WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS ARE OPTIONAL. THE SIGN OF PEACE MAY NOW BE REINTRODUCED.
HOLY COMMUNION ARRANGEMENTS REMAIN AS PREVIOUS BUT SUBJECT TO REVIEW IN LINE WITH THE STEWARDING ARRANGEMENTS. STEWARDS WILL INVITE THE CONGREGATION TO HOLY COMMUNION AT WEEKENDS. THE EXIT AT THE END OF MASS WILL BE FREE FLOW.
THE HOLY WATER STOOP WILL BE REINSTATED IN THE PORCH.
TOILETS ARE OPEN BUT MUST BE SANITISED AFTER EVERY USE.
Whilst this reduction of restrictions brings about a more normal way of living, the Covid-19 virus is still in circulation, and this should be in the mind of those participating in the life of the Church as time goes forward holding in balance the need for personal safety and taking responsibility for that safety.
