### Parish Clustering.

My dear friends, last Tuesday I attended the first deanery meeting for the Walsall and Lichfield deanery. During this meeting we discussed the clustering of parishes. I'd say we're probably 12 years behind Stoke parishes. There is an agenda in that by 2030 we shall go from 250 parishes in the diocese to just 50 parishes. This means that many parishes will eventually be joined, so we'll have a parish with 2, 3 or 4 churches in them being run by one priest and lay assistants.

As part of this process, our Parish of Saint Mary's will now be clustered with Holy Cross at Stone Cross, and Saint Michael's West Bromwich. Fr Daniel at West Bromwich also has pastoral care of Stone Cross.

I will be meeting with Fr Daniel sometime during lent to discuss the way ahead. At this point in time, we will be looking at supporting one another in our ministry. This will inevitably mean that there will be changes to times of masses; but this would have to be agreed by Bishop Timothy. I have listened intensively to parishioners over the past couple of years, and I think we could lose a couple of masses during the week. Saturday evening masses will also be looked at, and Sunday Mass times too. Our attendance at mass has steadily increased in the past 2 years, but it's now tailing off. We also need to take into consideration our finances, which you are aware, isn't brilliant. Therefore, Fr Daniel and I will begin to work more

closely together for the pastoral care of three churches, and to enable us to do that, we will need to be more available to each other, to support one another, and in doing so, ensure the pastoral care of our communities.

It is envisaged that within the next 4 years, there will be 1 parish with three churches, being looked after by a priest and some assistants, mainly lay assistants, but also, maybe a deacon or a curate.

There will be 1 Parish Council covering the 3 churches, and one Financial Council. Members of both councils will be sought from all 3 parishes. There will be 1 bank account for all 3 churches. Obviously, 2 churches will lose their status as a Parish, I believe.

The position of Parish priest for the new parish will be at the appointment of the Archbishop and by the agreement of the Priest concerned.

There is no decision to close churches now, however, we must face the fact that this will be inevitable in the future, but there is no agenda to close any church at this time.

I do hope that this has explained something of what we are to expect, and I'd be happy to answer any questions or concerns you may have.

On a lighter note, the Bishop asked me my thoughts of joining the Walsall Deanery, I told him that it felt like I was coming out of the Darkness into the Light. Wulfrunians will get the joke; Bishop Timothy having lived in Wolverhampton for a while found it very funny.

Meet and greet. We are currently looking for people who would like to greet and welcome people as they enter church and give them a newsletter and hymn and Mass books. If you think you'd like to help, then please have a word with Mary Jones, or Fr Michael. Thank you. My thanks to those who have done it for some time and have now decided to step back.
